  - 4. Remove and dispose of existing Steel Roofing
  - Roof Insulation: R-Seal (Therm-All) 1.5" thick R9.8 Polyurethane core Insulation Tongue and Groove Panel with WMPVR vapor barrier both sides installed to existing steel roof frame
